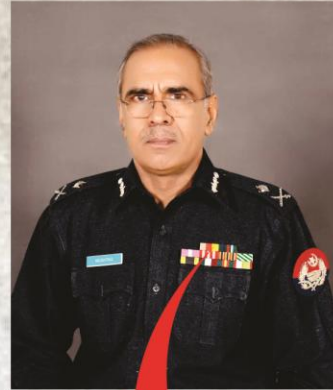


## MESSAGE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL OF PUNJAB POLICE

## HISTORY OF POLICE COLLEGE SIHALA

The foundation of Sihala College was laid in 1959 to provide training to officials of all ranks. Since its inception, Sihala has remained the premier alma-mater of police cadets. Sihala is the oldest and largest training college of police in Pakistan. The 1973 batch of ASsP of 1<sup>st</sup> Common Training Programme was sent here for training in 1975, while directly appointed DIGs and SsP from armed forces were trained here during 1975-77. To date, 35 commandants have served this College. Sihala has the pride of training 77,408 officers of national and international law enforcement agencies.

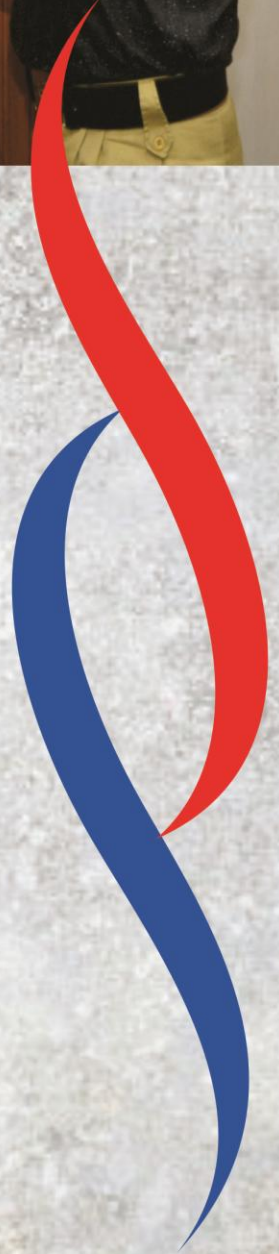


# BIOMETRICS

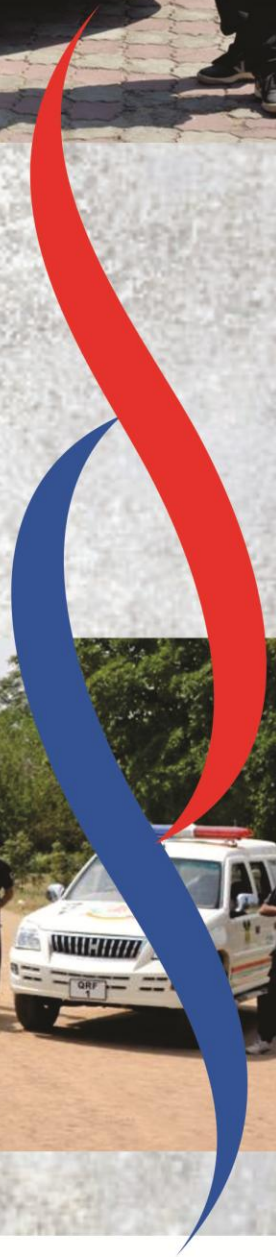
